Missionaries of the Week: Garrett & Joanna Schlake

*In February, I co-directed a week-long GBU ski camp in the French Alps with the focus on evangelism. The group was predominantly non-Christian students; three of the Chinese students were particularly impacted by the Bible studies, group discussions, one-on-one time and the community. During our sharing time at the end of the week, Mingrui, one of the Chinese students, said he found our group to be a family he could openly share and learn about God with, and his friend, Pengfei, explained how the week completely changed his view on God and Jesus. For all but one of the Chinese students it was their first-time hearing about and reading the Bible. *This generation of students has been beaten down and isolated by Covid, and one would think this would make them hunger for face-to-face interaction but the "comfort and security" of self-isolation has strangled many students' social lives. *Amid all this there is good news! We have two sisters in our ministry, Louise and Esther, who both have a heart for evangelism and have given our ministry a major boost! *Two weeks ago, Louise helped me organize an evangelism & apologetics evening. It was focused on the question of "Why do we exist?" Funny enough, one of our students invited a non-Christian friend who just so happened to ask him about this question that day!
