*We celebrated our first anniversary on May 15! In April we had a Christian student weekend around the theme of "Rest". *One personal encouragement from the weekend came up this last week. During my workshop I challenged the students to split into pairs and hold one-another accountable to read the Bible every day for 30 days straight. Two of the guys from it were so excited they told me as soon as they made it the 30 days!

*The biggest challenge I find in French ministry is how frequently students change schools and cities. Often you only have them for 2 years and then they are gone. Also, if they are international students, they will most likely work evenings and weekends and thus not be available for most ministry events and activities. *Thankfully, God continues to provide great students with a heart for the lost, but we really need your prayers that God would provide more so we somehow get some of these students to stay longer than two years! *After a year of praying a trying to invite non-Christians, our group at Paul Sabatier University is growing and finally appears stable! Most importantly non-Christians are coming, and our students are doing a great job making them feel welcomed! Covid cases are way down and no more major restrictions! Just this last week we were finally allowed to take public transportation without masks on and students are more and more at ease to engage in conversations on campus; a huge blessing after a tough 2 years! *The school year is coming to an end and our three student leaders are graduating, so please pray the transition would go well for our new student leaders, specifically for the group at Mirail University who still needs one!
