* Lucas and Luana will not be returning to the Nambikuara ministry for at least 4 years and possibly not at all. When the pandemic hit, they went to Brasília to help at their mission headquarters. While there, Lucas was elected to be the executive director - which is a four-year commitment. * Once again a missionary couple we have mentored and invested in are leaving the work. We realize that Lucas is very qualified to be a director and that they are unable to go to the villages now because the government is still restricting access to indigenous areas due to the virus, but we are disappointed. *Just as we were hit with this discouraging news, we received news that another missionary couple (whom we know and have helped in the past) are studying linguistics and in the near future may be able to assume the revision project. Please pray for God to equip Sergio and Rita as they look to God for His plan for them in the Nambikuara ministry. * Our dear friend and colleague, Nil, now has Covid. She is very weak already from the chemo treatments and this is a serious complication. Eduardo is discouraged - he desires to be in the villages doing discipleship but needs to care for his wife and two sons. They live 450 miles from the reservation in a city where medical treatment is available. Although he tries to maintain contact with the few villagers that have cell phones, his contact is limited. *The believers need a "shepherd" and a teacher. They need to read and apply the Word to their lives. Please pray for God to raise up from among the people themselves a strong spiritual leader. One Nambikuara young man (Anaelson) is currently at Bible School. Pray that he will become strong in his faith and be a witness to his people. He is a quiet, shy fellow but serious about his walk with Jesus.

Dr. Randy White is known for his fervor for studying the Bible and theology and his zeal for proclaiming it. Randy White Ministries was started in 2011 as an online and radio Bible teaching ministry. Today, the ministry is focused on producing verse-by-verse Bible teaching resources for individuals. Dr. White produces about 10 hours of new video weekly, including the daily *Ask the Theologian* broadcast, a Q&A for Biblical, theological, and worldview issues. Our Thursday night Bible study is an “online exclusive,” and reaches people from around the world. We also broadcast the Sunday and Wednesday teaching from the pulpit of Taos (NM) First Baptist Church. All broadcasts can be found on the home page of our website. They will appear at the top of the page on the day of the broadcast.

White has almost 30 years of pastoral experience—including the First Baptist Churches of Munday, TX (1992-1995), Kaufman, TX (1995-1999), Pampa, TX (1999-2003), Katy, TX (2003-2015) and Taos, NM (2015 – present). He has ministered in both large and tiny churches and loves the pastoral and pulpit ministry.

Dr. White regularly leads tours of the Holy Land. A frequent talk radio guest, he is also the author of numerous books and Bible study resources.

Randy has a Bachelor of Business Administration degree, a Master of Divinity with Biblical Languages, and a Doctor of Ministry degree.

With enthusiasm for dispensational theology, Dr. White launched Dispensational Publishing House. As the founder and chief executive officer of DPH, White has a megaphone through which he can shout his love for dispensational theology—always reminding readers to “question the assumptions.” It is White’s desire to make DPH the go-to source for sound theology, thought-provoking content from a variety of writers and the latest information—all from the traditional dispensational perspective.

Randy White and his wife Shelley live in Taos, N.M., where he serves as the pastor of Taos First Baptist Church. They have two adult children, both happily married and raising their families.
