- A. Let us be sober (1Th. 5:6-7).
 - 1. (vs. 6) The conduct of wayward people;
 - a. "For those who sleep do their sleeping at night,"
 - b. "and those who get drunk get drunk at night."
 - 2. (vs. 7) "But since we are of the day," our conduct should be different:
 - a. "let us be sober"
 - 1) "having put on the breastplate of faith and love."

2) "and as a helmet, the hope of salvation."

- B. Destined for obtaining salvation (1Th. 5:9-10).
 - 1. (vs. 9) Paul explained:
 - a. "For God has not destined us for wrath,"
 - b. "but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ,"
 - 2. (vs. 10) He it is, "who died for us" purpose:
 - a. "so that whether we are awake or asleep,"
 - b. "we will live together with Him."

- C. Our appropriate response to this good news (1Th. 5:11).
 - 1. "Therefore encourage one another"
 - 2. "and build up one another" -
 - "just as you also are doing."
